MEMBERSHIP is provided to adults 60 years or older, and their spouses (regardless of age), and members of National AARP over 50 years. There is no membership fee to participate. Membership priority is given to Alexander County Residents, but any County resident is welcome. We are funded through the Home and Community Care Block Grant—Older Americans Act, Title III-B, Title III-D, as well as Alexander County funds. Memberships are free but the center welcomes voluntary contributions which go toward the Senior Center operating Budget.

Health and Wellness Programs

A variety of programs are offered to help older adults remain healthy as well as develop and maintain strength, balance and agility. These include exercise classes, Tai Chi, A Matter of Balance classes, Health support seminars, dancing and a variety of health and wellness resources, including a lending library of videos, books, and periodicals, and internet access.

Educational Programs

Mental agility is also important. A wide range of experiences including Musicians' Jam, art & crafts, use of modern technology in our computer lab, a lending library that includes large print books and audio booksfor free! We have guest speakers that do presentation on a wide-range of topics related to senior health, Medicare issues, nutrition, exercise, and services.

Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment

January 1 - March 31

If you're enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan, there are certain changes you are able to make during the first quarter of the year .Call for and appointment with a SHIIP counselor for more information, 828-632-1717.



We are always looking to assist those who might qualify for the "Extra Help" Program through Social Security to get help with the cost of their drug plan and their prescription drug costs. This is a program with both income & resource limits that must be met. This year's guidelines:

Married

Income: \$1,823 /month. \$2,465/month

Resources: \$16.660 \$33.240



Resources include bank accounts, pensions, 401K, stocks, bonds, land not attached to your home, etc. Not your home, cars, personal property.

If your numbers are at or below these numbers, please call the Senior Center at 632-1717, so we can schedule an appointment to file an application online for you! Or you can call NC Department of Insurance Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP) for assistance at 855-408-1212. This is a FREE service.

Note: you must have Medicare Part A & B to apply. You can apply anytime during the year—you do NOT have to wait for Open Enrollment.


